

# Rocket Quilt Guild Mystery Quilt 2018

October 2018 to April 2019

Instructions and diagrams are shown using the “Winter” color scheme (from Clue #1), but you should substitute those colors with the fabrics you’ve chosen for your quilt.

Fill in your fabric names in the grid below (“Your Fabric” column) to easily remind you which fabrics to use where.

The number of strips, squares, units for the 46” x 58” and 46” x 46” quilts are shown in brackets [ ] after the number for the 58” x 70” quilt.

For example, “cut 5 [or 3, or 2] @ 2” x WOF strips” means:

- “cut 5 strips of fabric to size 5” x WOF per strip for the 58” x 70” quilt”
- “cut 3 strips of fabric to size 3” x WOF per strip for the 46” x 58” quilt”
- “cut 2 strips of fabric to size 2” x WOF per strip for the 46” x 46” quilt”

Let’s get started with Clue #5!

Number of Strips to Cut (see below for details):

Fabric #	Fabric	Your Fabric	“Winter” Fabric	Quilt Size 58” x 70”	Quilt Size 46” x 58”	Quilt Size 46” x 46”
7	Light #2 print (background)		White with Blue Print	4 strips @ 6-1/2”	3 strips @ 6-1/2”	2 strips @ 6-1/2”

### Cut Fabrics as follows:

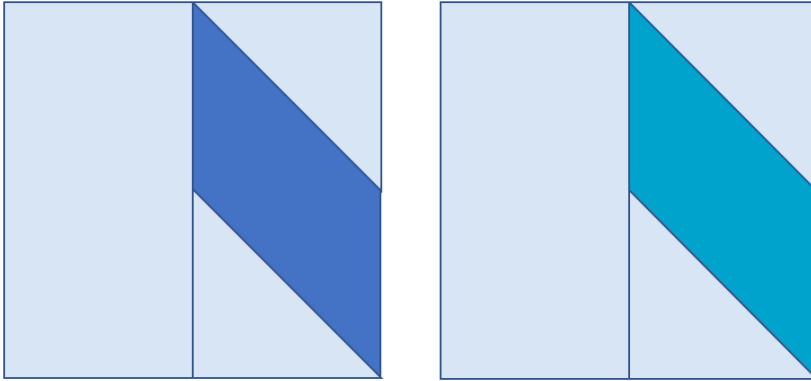
From Light #2 print (background) fabric:

- Cut 4 [or 3, or 2] @ 6-1/2” x WOF strips
- Then re-cut into 40 [or 24, or 20] @ 3-1/2” x 6-1/2” rectangles.



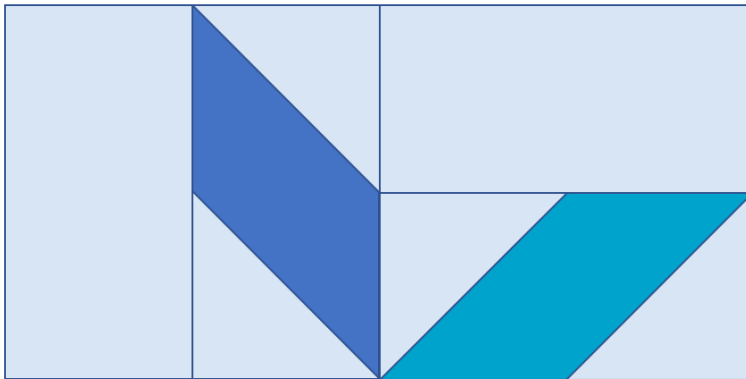
**Complete Block #2:**

1. Sew a  $3\text{-}1/2$ " x  $6\text{-}1/2$ " **Light #2 print (background)** rectangle to 1 long side of each **Dark** and **Dark-Medium** pieced unit to make **20** [or 12, or 10] each  $6\text{-}1/2$ " x  $6\text{-}1/2$ " **Dark** and **Dark-Medium** block quarters.



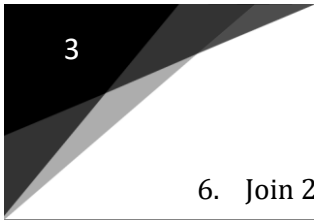
**Diagram 1**

2. Press seams toward the rectangles.
3. Stitch a **Dark** block quarter to a **Dark-Medium** block quarter to make a  $6\text{-}1/2$ " x  $12\text{-}1/2$ " row.



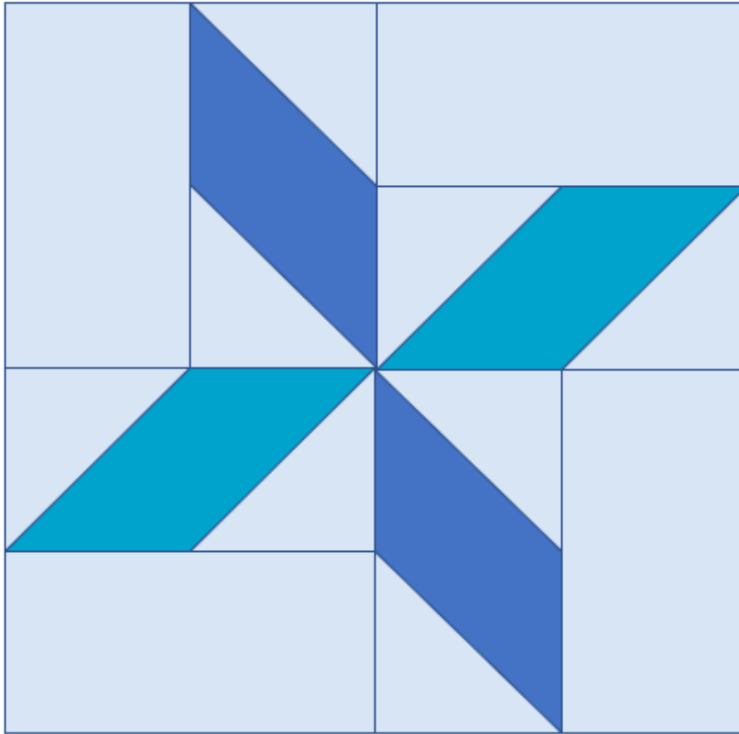

4. Press seam toward the **Dark** block quarter.
5. Repeat to make **20** [or 12, or 10] rows.



Clue #5

6. Join 2 rows to complete a 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" Pinwheel block.

7. Press seam to 1 side.
8. Repeat to make **10** [or 6, or 5] blocks.

We'll put the blocks together next month, to make the quilt top.
