
Rocket Quilters' 2016 Mystery Quilt Clue 2

Block Assembly Instructions:

- 1. Place one 3-7/8" Fabric I square on top of one 3-7/8" Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two IG units (Fig. 3). Trim the IG units to measure 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make thirty- two IG units total.
- 2. Repeat Step 1 with twelve 3-7/8" Fabric I squares and twelve 3-7/8" Fabric E squares to make



- 3. Sew together one 3-1/2" Fabric C square, one 3-1/2" Fabric F square and two IG units to make one comer block (Fig. 5). Repeat to make four comer blocks total.
- 4. Follow Figure 6 and sew one Fabric D large triangle, one Fabric E small triangle, one Fabric I small triangle and one IE unit together to make one Left Point Block. Repeat to make four Left Point Blocks total.
- 5. Follow Figure 7 and sew one Fabric D large triangle, one Fabric E small triangle, one Fabric I small triangle and one IE unit together to make one Right Point Block. Repeat to make four Right Point Blocks total.
- 6. Sew together one Left Point Block and one Right Point Block to make one Star Point Block (Fig. 8).
