

## Rocket Quilter's 2016 Mystery Quilt Clue 4

### Quilt Top Assembly Instructions:

*Refer to the Quilt Layout below while assembling the quilt top.*

11. Sew together two corner blocks, two 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric H stripe and one 12-1/2" x 24 1/2" Fabric B strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row.
12. Sew together two 12-1/2" x 24T/2" Fabric B strips, two 2-1/2 x 24T/2" Fabric H strips and the 24-1/2" Center block to make the middle row.
13. Sew the three rows together with the two 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" Fabric H strip, alternating the rows and strips to make the quilt top.
14. Sew one 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" Fabric D strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
15. Sew one 5-1/2" x 56-1/2" Fabric A strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 5-1/2" x 66-1/2" Fabric A strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
16. Layer and quilt as desired.
17. Sew the seven 2-1/2" x WOF Fabric D binding strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
18. Bind as Desired.
